



Adding a Soil Sample

[1] Ensure you have accessed your Location (a), then expand the (+) icons in the Menu Tree under Samples. Click the Soil link (b) to view and/or add a sample. To add a new sample click the (+) (c).



[2a] Complete the Administrative data and obtain a DOEHR ID.



If the 'OEHSA/ Exposure Pathway' reason is selected, associated one as shown below.

Pick the sampling point from the drop down. New sampling points are managed from the Sampling link.

[2b] Associate an EP (a) when the sample reason is 'OEHSA/Exposure Pathway' and add the remaining Field Data (b).
