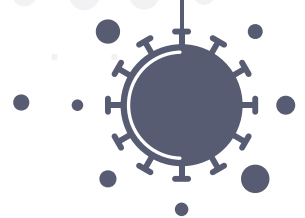

COVID-19 Vaccines are Effective & Safe



All the vaccines available are effective at preventing severe illness and hospitalization.

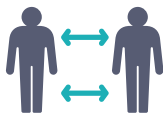
Severe Allergic Reactions are Rare

Fewer than **0.01%** of those who received vaccines experienced a severe allergic reaction, including anaphylaxis. Occurrence of adverse reactions is similar to those of other licensed vaccines, including the flu vaccine.
