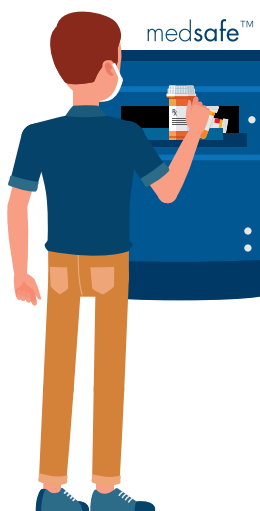


Got Meds?

Safely discard your unused/unwanted household medications

Improper disposal of unwanted medications can harm streams, aquatic life, and our drinking water.

Ways to Safely Dispose:



Take to your military treatment facility's **Medsafe™ blue bin** for safe collection.



Mix with something unpalatable, like kitty litter or coffee grounds, seal, and **discard in the trash.**



Take to a **local collection event** in your community.

Did you know?

Due to the risk of accidental exposure to family members and pets, some medications should be flushed. **Visit the FDA's web site to see whether your medication is on the "flush list."**

Don't flush medications not on this list!

Examples of medications that should be flushed: Fentanyl, Morphine, Oxycodone, Methadone, Hydrocodone, and Diazepam
